Service Reports

Water

- Gary reported the water situation is good at the moment despite being dry in March and April. It will be a slow recovery. Be on the look out for leaks.

Roads

Tractor

• Dan Halsted bought a new battery which seems to have fixed the electrical issues.

Dumpster

• Gary asked Mike to report on the dumpster. There was some damage done to the containers and the gate by the collection company. Reminder to break down boxes. Post a list of items that the trash company won't take; recycling was mentioned as a service provided through the trash company.

Old Business

- Non Jefferson County residents voting on tax issues-Gary followed-up with county, he was referred to the steward. They said they were mailed, but never received. Next time, we need to monitor it more closely and then contact the steward.
- **Tanglewood**-No news
- Shaffer's Crossing/ Crow Ranch- Janice reported on the north section-commissioners approved camping and RV storage.
- Other old business- Kathy Hartman the Commissioner was voted out. There was discussion of inviting the new Commissioner to the fall meeting to discuss the community and development along Elk Creek. Question about whether or not anyone is noticing/measuring Elk Creek water levels?
- **Voter issues**-Gary called the election commission regarding ballots being mailed out; the commission said they had outsourced it to a special agent. The recreation center ballots were not mailed out. The recreation center failed, but the Journey Church is building a recreation district.
- **DSL**-Century Link- If enough people request DSL, then they will extend infrastructure for additional lines..
