Review and Approval of Treasurer's Report

Water

Old Business

- Non Jeffco residents voting on tax issues-Gary followed-up with county, he was referred to the steward. They said they were mailed, but never received. Next time we need to monitor it more closely and then contact steward. Next election is recreation district. Post information on website.
- **Tanglewood**-they have received approval to remove 1.7 cubic feet of water per minute from Elk Creek. They will not be returning it to Elk Creek, but instead the will dump it into another ditch that returns it to the South Platt.
- **Shaffer's Crossing Ranch-** Gary has not received any information, but Bob mentioned that the Pine Library just received some information.
- **Other old business**-Stu talked about Clean Colorado elections-he talked about other issues on the ballot that were negative, rather than being defeated, they've removed it for the next weekend

New Business

- Water shutoff-The target for shutting off the waters is the end of September, but it may have to be pushed up depending on the weather. This weekend it was 39 degrees, will wait and see.
- **Trash-** Trash clean up will take place immediately after the meeting from 11:30 until completed. Everyone was reminded to sign a waiver if they have not done so.
- Buck Snort- the Buck Snort has new containers which are not bear proof.
- **Phone Service**-There was discussion regarding phone service. Apparently, Quest isn't taking new customers at this time.
- Grading of roads an issue-Mark volunteered to help with roads
